## 1786 - CHAPTER 54.

AN ACT MAKING PERPETUAL, AN ACT RESPECTING THE GRAMMAR SCHOOL, in IRBWICH, IN THE COUNTY OF ESSEX.

whereas a Law respecting the said School, was enacted in the year one thousand seven hundred and sixty five, to be in force for the term of twenty one years, from the first day of March, one thousand seven hundred and sixty six, which has been found beneficial, and to answer the purposes for which it was enacted:

Be it therefore Enacted, by the Senate, and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, That the said Law, entitled, "An Act for regulating the grammar School in Ipswich, in the county of Essex, and for incorporating certain persons to manage and direct the same," Be and hereby is made perpetual.
